
Learning: Encourages students to make choices in content and assessment methods based on their experiences, values, needs, and strengths.

Equitable: Respectful learning environments in which students racial and ethnic diversity is valued and contributes to successful academic outcomes

Achievement: Includes multiple ways to represent knowledge and skills and allow for attainment of outcomes at different points in time

## How do I implement this strategy?

- 1. To complete this strategy, you will need a short reading passage that is grade level appropriate, highlighters, and post its.
- 2. Scholars read the provided passage.
- 3. When scholars are reading, ask them to be "on the lookout" for a word that impacted them as powerful. Ask the scholars to highlight that word.
- 4. After scholars have chosen their word, they can write their word in the middle of their post-it. Then, scholars can draw pictures and decorate around the word.
- 5. Facilitate a community share.



## Application Tips & Tricks

- Scholars can also write their words in their home / primary language, if applicable.
- This can be done independently, in small groups, with partners, or in a large group.
   Choose which option best fits the scholars you serve.
- We suggest modeling this strategy first on a DocCam. You could also prepare an example on Google Slides to share with scholars.
